A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MISCELLANEOUS JAIL SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY JAIL, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of miscellaneous jail surveillance equipment for the City jail, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and, WHEREAS, bids were received on September 19, 1978, as shown on the attached Exhibit "A"; and,
