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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CANCELLING PURCHASE ORDER TO TRAFFIC SUPPLIES, INC. AND AWARING BID TO VEPEd TRAFFIC CONTROLS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIGN FACE MATERIALS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave notice, as required by law, for bids for the purchase of sign face materials, meeting specifications, for use by the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on the 14th day of March, A.D. 1978, and purchases authorized on April 13, 1978; and,

WHEREAS, Traffic Supplies, Inc., the supplier of the lowest bids for Items 1 and 2 on Bid #284 has been unable or unwilling to perform; and,

WHEREAS, the second lowest bidder on the above said bids, VePed Traffic Controls of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, is willing, at this date, to honor those same bids; and,

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the City continue its traffic sign placement and rehabilitation program with as little inefficiency and difficulty as possible; and,

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the bids of VePed Traffic Controls, for Items 1 and 2 on Bid #284 dated March 14, 1978, in the total amount of Twelve Thousand Two Hundred Fourteen and 28/100ths (\$12,214.28) Dollars, should be accepted; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the purchase order to Traffic Supplies, Inc. for sign face materials in the amount of Eleven Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Nine and 16/100ths (\$11,949.16) Dollars, be, and the same is hereby, in all things, cancelled.

PART 2: That the bids of VePed Traffic Controls, for Items 1 and 2 on Bid #284 dated March 14, 1978, in the total amount of \$12,214.28, be, and the same are hereby, in all things, approved and accepted.

PART 3: That the Purchasing Agent be, and he is hereby authorized to make such purchases from said company.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
