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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A LIQUID POLYMER STORAGE TANK FOR THE HAMBY PLANT, MEETING SPECIFICATIONS, FOR USE BY THE CITY OF ABILENE.
