

RESOLUTION NO. 22-1984

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, WAIVING THE OIL AND GAS LEASE REQUIREMENT TO BURY ELECTRICAL LINES.

WHEREAS, the City Council and the lessee, Abilene Exploration, Inc., James R. Alexander, President, entered into an oil and gas lease through assignment November, 1983, on the Lake Kirby Field "D" Lease, and August, 1983, on the Lake Kirby Field "C" Lease; and,

WHEREAS, the lessee, Abilene Exploration, Inc., has installed overhead electrical lines, but the leases referred to the burying of such lines; and,

WHEREAS, the burial of such lines is not necessary at this time at these locations; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the lessee is hereby waived of the requirement stated in Exhibit A, paragraph 4 of the oil and gas leases currently in effect on these two (2) tracts concerning the underground installation of electrical lines, SAVE AND EXCEPT for a 400-foot East-West strip of land lying adjacent to and parallel with the east right-of-way line of present US Highway 83-84.


PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its adoption.
