

RESOLUTION NO. 33-1984

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, DECLARING A PUBLIC NECESSITY FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF LINDA JOY AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THIS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstruct Linda Joy between Sayles Boulevard and Buffalo Gap Road and construct an intersection transition at Sayles and South 20th; and,

WHEREAS, there is no need to acquire right-of-way to proceed with this project; and,

WHEREAS, this project is being pursued in cooperation with the United States Post Office, South Branch; and,

WHEREAS, the United States Post Office, South Branch, is willing to participate in the funding for their portion of the curb and gutter; and,

WHEREAS, reconstruction of Linda Joy and the intersection at Sayles and South 20th at this time is much more economical during construction of the United States Post Office, South Branch, than it would be after the new Post Office, South Branch facility is operating; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby authorizes the appropriation of 1980 General Obligation Bond funds for the City's portion, approximately \$102,000, contingent upon United States Post Office, South Branch, participation of approximately \$10,000 for this reconstruction project.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
