

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TAYLOR ELECTRIC CO-OPERATIVE, INC. RURAL RATE CASE AND SUSPENDING THE LOCAL INCREASE.

WHEREAS, Taylor Electric Cooperative, Inc. has filed an application for a system-wide increase to become effective July 16, 1984; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Abilene (450 meters) for the Council to suspend the proposed rate increase for a period of ninety (90) days so that the proposed increase can be studied and evaluated; and;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Abilene to participate in the rural case before the Texas Public Utility Commission; now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council hereby approves and authorizes the filing of "Motion To Intervene," and the City Attorney is authorized to participate in this electric utility case filed on June 11, 1984.

PART 2: That the City Council hereby suspends the proposed rate increase for ninety (90) days beyond the July 16, 1984, date on which the schedule of rates would otherwise go into effect, in order that the City Council will have time to study the proposed rate increase.

PART 3: That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to notify Taylor Electric Cooperative, Inc. that the proposed increase is hereby suspended for ninety (90) days.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
