

RESOLUTION NO. 48-1984

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, SUSPENDING THE PROPOSED JUNE 21, 1984, RATE INCREASE FOR NINETY (90) DAYS.

WHEREAS, Lone Star Gas Company has filed a Statement of Intent to change Residential and Commercial Rates, to become effective July 27, 1984; and,

WHEREAS, the Gas Utility Regulatory Act requires the City Council to retain any and all personnel necessary to make the determination of reasonable rates; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council needs additional time to study the proposed rate increase; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council hereby suspends the proposed rate increase for ninety (90) days beyond the July 27, 1984 date on which the schedule of rates would otherwise go into effect; in order that the City Council will have time to study the proposed rate increase.

PART 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to retain any and all personnel necessary, to examine the proposed rate change.

PART 3: That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to notify Lone Star Gas Company that the proposed increase is hereby suspended for ninety (90) days.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
