

RESOLUTION NO. 49-1984

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, DECLARING A PUBLIC NECESSITY FOR THE RELOCATION OF A 69KV H-FRAME TRANSMISSION LINE ALONG HIGHWAY 83-84 NEAR ANTILLEY ROAD.

WHEREAS, due to increased growth and development in the southeast portion of the City of Abilene, there is a need to relocate this West Texas Utilities transmission line to better serve this area; and,

WHEREAS, Option #2 is to relocate 7,405 feet of transmission line from North Windmill Circle to a point 360 feet north of Spur 707; and,

WHEREAS, there is no need to acquire additional right-of-way to proceed with Option #2; and,

WHEREAS, constructing Option #2 at this time is much more economical than accomplishing it on a piece-meal basis over an extended period of time; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby authorizes the appropriation of 1980 General Obligation Bond Funds for the construction of this relocation at an approximate cost of \$56,680, plus provide West Texas Utilities with the required easement to accomplish this relocation.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
