

RESOLUTION NO. 59-1984

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING THE ABILENE CULTURAL AFFAIRS COUNCIL TO COORDINATE THE TEXAS SESQUICENTENNIAL CULTURAL EXCHANGE WITH ELIZABETH, SOUTH AUSTRALIA.

WHEREAS, the State of South Australia will be celebrating their 150th anniversary in 1986; and,

WHEREAS, an integral part of Texas' Sesquicentennial celebration will be the cultural exchange between these two states; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Elizabeth has been chosen by the Texas Sesquicentennial Commission to be Abilene's sister-city during the celebration of the Sesquicentennial; and,

WHEREAS, the Abilene City Council embraces the concept of the sister-city project and the advancement of cultural exchange; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the Abilene Cultural Affairs Council be designated to coordinate and organize this project to the mutual benefit of Abilene and Elizabeth.

PART 2: That the City Council congratulates the City of Elizabeth and the State of South Australia on the occasion and celebration of their 150th anniversary.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
