

RESOLUTION NO. 61-1984

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TAYLOR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT TO ESTABLISH A COORDINATED HEALTH PROGRAM UNDER PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH REORGANIZATION ACT, ARTICLE 4436-b, V.T.C.S. AND TO ALLOW THE ABILENE-TAYLOR COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO INVESTIGATE AND ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF TEXAS CLEAN AIR ACT, TEXAS WATER QUALITY ACT AND TEXAS SOLID WASTE ACT.

WHEREAS, provisions of the Local Public Health Reorganization Act, Article 4436-b, V.T.C.S. allows governing bodies to form agreements to organize public health districts for conducting coordinated health programs, and

WHEREAS, provisions in the Texas Clean Air Act, Texas Water Quality Act and the Texas Solid Waste Act allow governments to enforce these acts at the local level; and

WHEREAS, Taylor County desires to enter into an agreement with the City of Abilene to organize a public health district for conducting programs within the provisions of these acts; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene is of the opinion that such an agreement would be beneficial to the City of Abilene and to Taylor County; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the Mayor of the City of Abilene is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, with Taylor County, Texas, to establish a public health district and conduct a coordinated health program under the provisions of the above acts.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
