

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AMBULANCE RATE INCREASES FOR ABILENE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE.

WHEREAS, according to City Ordinance No. 729, codified at Section 5-3 of the Abilene City Code, the City Council shall determine the rates to be charged for all ambulance services within the City of Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, Abilene Emergency Medical Service has requested a rate increase; and,

WHEREAS, after notice and public hearing, the City Council hereby determines that it is in the best interest of all the citizens of Abilene to grant the following rate increases; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the following rate changes for ambulance service by Abilene Emergency Medical Service are hereby authorized:

<u>Service Item</u>	<u>New Rates</u>
Base Rate	\$75.00
Mileage/per mile	\$ 2.00
Oxygen	\$15.00
Night	\$ 7.50
Emergency	\$15.00
Waiting/per hour	\$60.00
Advance Life Support (EKG, Telemetry, I.V., etc.)	\$50.00

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately after its adoption.
