

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, REAPPOINTING PHILIP L. WETHERBEE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE FOR A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS.

WHEREAS, Philip L. Wetherbee was originally appointed Municipal Court Judge on November 18, 1976, and

WHEREAS, Section 76 of the Abilene City Charter provides that the Municipal Court Judge can be appointed for a term of two (2) years; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene is of the opinion that Philip L. Wetherbee has honorably served his community and should be reappointed for a new two (2) year term as Municipal Court Judge, beginning November 18, 1984; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene approves of the appointment of Philip L. Wetherbee as Municipal Court Judge of Abilene, Texas, and hereby authorizes the Mayor, David Stubbeman, to appoint Philip L. Wetherbee as Municipal Court Judge for a term of two (2) years beginning November 18, 1984, through November 30, 1986.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect as of November 18, 1984.
