

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR A GRANT UNDER THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT OF 1964, AS AMENDED (FY-85).

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make grants for mass transportation projects; and,

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs; and,

WHEREAS, it is required by the U. S. Department of Transportation in accord with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the U. S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and,

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definitive procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority businesses shall have maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts when procuring construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services;

WHEREAS, due notice of a public hearing had been given and all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the Mayor is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Abilene with the U. S. Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of a capital assistance project pursuant to Section 5 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

PART 2: That the Mayor is authorized to execute and file with such application an assurance or any other document required by the U. S. Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

PART 3: That the City Manager is authorized to furnish such additional information as the U. S. Department of Transportation may require in connection with the application or the project.

PART 4: That the Mayor is authorized to set forth and execute the affirmative minority business policies in connection with the project's procurement needs.

PART 5: That the Mayor is authorized to execute grant contract agreements on behalf of the City of Abilene with the U. S. Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of the operating assistance projects.

PART 6: That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.
