

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CREATING AND APPOINTING LAKE FORT PHANTOM DEVELOPMENT TASK FORCE COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has been requested to examine Lake Fort Phantom; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that such a review and examination would be in the best interest of the City of Abilene, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: That the Lake Fort Phantom Development Task Force Committee is hereby created to evaluate and study the following areas:

(A) Whether development is desirable and/or feasible, economically or practically; considering the interests of the present residents and the public interests of all the citizens of Abilene, for the area immediately around Lake Fort Phantom, some of which is presently under lease, so as to enhance and improve the lake.

(B) Whether development is desirable and/or feasible, economically or practically; considering the interests of the present residents immediately around the Lake Fort Phantom and the public interests of all the citizens of Abilene, as to other City owned land near Fort Phantom Lake, so as to enhance and improve the lake.

Part 2: That the Lake Fort Phantom Development Task Force Committee is charged with the responsibility of making a report to the Planning and Zoning Commission if zone changes or land usage changes are recommended and making a final report to the City Council regarding Lake Fort Phantom. The Committee will have fulfilled its responsibility and charge once the final report is presented to the City Council.

Part 3: That the individuals appointed by the Mayor are hereby approved by the City Council.

Part 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
