

RESOLUTION NO. 11-1986

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF ABILENE ON APRIL 5, 1986.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of February, A.D. 1986, the City Council of the City of Abilene, by proper resolution and proclamation, called a general election to be held in said city on the first Saturday in April, 1986, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of said city; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has duly canvassed the returns of such election and has ascertained the results thereof; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene finds and declares the results of such election as per the attached.

PART 2: That it appearing that Welton Robinson received the majority of votes cast in said election for the office of Councilman Place V; and Harold Nixon received the majority of votes cast in said election for the office of Councilman Place VI; said candidates are hereby declared elected and shall take office in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Abilene.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
