A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING OF THE CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANTS FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Commission having reviewed and evaluated the request for historic grants recommends to this Council the approval of the grants; and,

WHEREAS, this Council has carefully considered the proposals and held a public hearing thereon finds that said grants constitute a suitable, logical, and timely endeavor for the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City of Abilene should proceed with the grant from the Texas Historic Commission for funding a project to develop a methodology of evaluation and rank local historic sites.

PART 2: That the City of Abilene should proceed with the grant from the Texas Historic Commission for funding a project to gather detailed documentation on Abilene's historic structures.
