

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ENDORSING THE MAYOR OF DALLAS' CRIMINAL JUSTICE TASK FORCE LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Criminal Justice Task Force's position is that the first function of government is to protect and safeguard the lives and property of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the law enforcement function is one of the government's top and most basic priority; and,

WHEREAS public officials, law enforcement support groups and concerned citizens have a strong desire to reform the criminal justice system to be more effective in preventing and reducing crime; and,

WHEREAS numerous problems facing the criminal justice system must be resolved through legislative reform at the state level; Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the Abilene City Council endorses the Dallas Mayor's Criminal Justice Task Force legislative package.

SECTION 2: That this legislative package be forwarded to the 70th session of the Texas State Legislature for their consideration.

SECTION 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Abilene, and is accordingly so resolved.
