

RESOLUTION NO. 11-1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, CONCERNING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH'S DECISION REGARDING ABILENE'S REGIONAL OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Abilene is concerned about the public health and welfare of the citizens of Abilene and the surrounding counties; and,

WHEREAS, the State Department of Health has decided to downgrade Abilene's Regional Office to a sub-regional status; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of Abilene ask the State Department of Health to reconsider its decision to downgrade Abilene's Regional Office and ask for an opportunity for input into any reorganization of the Health Department.

PART 2: That the City Council is concerned and strongly protests the planned actions because it has not been shown that the reorganization will be a more effective or efficient means of serving the citizens of Abilene and the surrounding counties.

PART 3: That the City Council is concerned and strongly protests the planned actions because the downgrading of Abilene's Regional Office may be detrimental to the public health and welfare of the citizens of Abilene and surrounding counties.

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
