

RESOLUTION NO. 18-1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, DECLARING PARTICIPATION IN THE ABILENE/TAYLOR COUNTY 9-1-1 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM AND APPROVING THE DISTRICT'S OPERATING BUDGET FOR FY 1986-87.

WHEREAS, the 9-1-1 Board of Managers met during a public meeting on April 8, 1987, and canvassed the returns of a 9-1-1 election, declaring that, pursuant to the votes cast, the Abilene/Taylor County 9-1-1 Emergency Communication District is created; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene desires to participate in the newly created Abilene/Taylor County 9-1-1 Emergency Communication District by receiving emergency telephone services, and

WHEREAS, Article 1432e, Section 7, requires that the 9-1-1 Board of Managers prepare and approve an annual budget and then present same to each participating jurisdiction in the District for final approval; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ABILENE, TEXAS;

PART 1: That the City of Abilene desires to participate in the 9-1-1 telephone service by receiving its emergency calls at the Police and Fire Communication Facility.

PART 2: That the operating budget for the FY 1986-87, as adopted by the 9-1-1 Board of Managers, is hereby approved.

PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption thereof.
