

RESOLUTION NO. 20-1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, WAIVING IMPROVEMENTS REQUIRED BY THE SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE ON THE FIRST EVANGELICAL METHODIST CHURCH ADDITION WHICH ABUTS BISHOP ROAD JUST OFF HIGHWAY 277.

WHEREAS, Section 23-260(6) of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Abilene imposes certain requirements relative to the installation of sanitary sewer improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Lyndon M. Curry, as Agent, has filed a request that these requirements of the sanitary sewer improvements on the First Evangelical Methodist Church Addition abutting Bishop Road just off Highway 277 be waived under the provisions of Section 23-262.8(A)(1) of said Subdivision Regulations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That upon consideration of the request of Lyndon M. Curry and after considering all relevant factors and staff recommendations in connection therewith, the City Council does hereby find and determine that it is in the best interest of the City to grant such request.

PART 2: That the City Council does hereby waive the requirements of Section 23-260(6) of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Abilene, Texas, relative to the installation of sanitary sewer improvements on the First Evangelical Methodist Church Addition abutting Bishop Road just off Highway 277, as set out and described on the final plat which has been filed in connection with this request.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from

and after its passage.
