

RESOLUTION NO. 35-1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE SIDEWALK MASTER PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene, after careful study and after a public hearing, has recommended to this Council the Sidewalk Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Council has carefully considered the Sidewalk Master Plan and has held a public hearing thereon and finds that said plan constitutes a suitable, logical and timely plan for present and future development of a sidewalk system; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the document consisting of text and map entitled "Sidewalk Master Plan" is hereby adopted.

PART 2: That in order that said plan shall at all times be current with the needs of the City of Abilene, and shall represent the concern of the Council, Planning and Zoning Commission and departments of the City that the plan be consistent with changing conditions, the Planning and Zoning Commission shall periodically review said document and recommend to the Council extensions, changes or additions which the Commission considers necessary.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
