

RESOLUTION NO. 60-1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, (HEREINAFTER CALLED "APPLICANT"), DESIGNATING CERTAIN OFFICIALS AS BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR ACTING FOR, AND ON BEHALF OF THE APPLICANT IN DEALING WITH THE TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT (HEREINAFTER CALLED "DEPARTMENT") FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARTICIPATING IN THE GRANT PROGRAMS DESCRIBED HEREINAFTER: CERTIFYING THAT THE APPLICANT IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE UNDER SUCH PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, The United States Congress has passed the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965 (Public Law 88-578), authorizing the Secretary of the Interior to provide financial assistance to states, and political subdivisions thereof, for outdoor recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature has adopted Section 13.309 et seq of the Parks and Wildlife Code, for the purpose of allowing the State of Texas, and its political subdivisions, to participate in the Federal program established under said Public Law 88-578, or such other programs as are hereinafter established by the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature has, in addition adopted Chapter 24 of the Parks and Wildlife Code, for the purpose of allowing the political subdivisions of the State of Texas, to participate in the Texas Local Parks, Recreation and Open Space Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant is fully eligible to receive assistance under these Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant is desirous of authorizing its administrative staff to represent and act for the Applicant in dealing with the Department concerning these Programs;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE APPLICANT:

Section 1: That the Applicant hereby certifies that the Applicant is ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ASSISTANCE UNDER THESE PROGRAMS.

Section 2: That the Applicant hereby authorizes and directs its City Manager to represent and act for the Applicant in dealing with the Department for the purpose of these programs. The City Manager is HEREBY OFFICIALLY DESIGNATED AS THE REPRESENTATIVE IN THIS REGARD.

Section 3: That the Applicant hereby designates its Director of Finance as the official authorized to serve as the Applicant's FISCAL OFFICER TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THESE PROGRAMS.

Section 4: The Applicant hereby specifically authorizes the officials to make application to the Department concerning the site to be known as Cal Young Park Softball Fields in the City of Abilene for use as a park site. THAT CAL YOUNG PARK SOFTBALL FIELDS ARE HEREBY DEDICATED (OR WILL BE DEDICATED UPON COMPLETION OF THE PROPOSED ACQUISITION) FOR PUBLIC OUTDOOR RECREATION PURPOSES.
