

RESOLUTION NO. 4-1988

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, REQUESTING LEGISLATIVE SUPPORT FROM THE STATE IN ACQUIRING AN ARMORED TANK BATTALION.

WHEREAS, a new armored brigade will be formed; and,

WHEREAS, the Adjutant General of Texas has prepared a stationing plan proposing the new armored brigade be stationed in the State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, the stationing plan is before the National Guard Bureau in Washington, D.C. for consideration; and,

WHEREAS, Bryan/College Station and Dallas areas are under consideration for future sites of two Armored Tank Battalions; and,

WHEREAS, Abilene could receive economic benefit if an Armored Tank Battalion is located in the Abilene area; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council hereby supports the location of an Armored Tank Battalion in Abilene;

PART 2: That the City Council respectfully requests Senator Grant Jones and Representative Bob Hunter to assist the Council, through State Funding, in its attempts to acquire an Armored Tank Battalion;

PART 3: That the City Council directs the staff to forward this Resolution to Senator Jones and Representative Hunter.
