

RESOLUTION NO. 5-1988

A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE'S POLICE DEPARTMENT TO THE GOVERNOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROPOSED "ABILENE MULTI-AGENCY PROPERTY CRIME AND ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM" FOR COMBATING CRIMINAL ACTIVITY IN THE AREA OF PROPERTY CRIMES.

WHEREAS the City of Abilene, Texas through its City Council and its Chief of police, desires to implement a program to proactively impact the current upward trend of property crimes in the City and surrounding area; and

WHEREAS The City of Abilene, Texas is of the belief that the creation of a Multi-Agency Property Crime and Enforcement Program would serve all the citizens by recovery of stolen property, and the return of such property to the rightful owners, as well as deterring property crimes in general through the effective prosecution of offenders; and

WHEREAS the City of Abilene, Texas is desirous of applying for matching funds now available for such a project as heretofore described to combat property crimes; now therefore,

BE IT NOW RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City of Abilene hereby agrees to make application to the Governor's Criminal Justice Division for funds to implement a program to combat property crimes.

PART 2: That the City of Abilene hereby agrees to abide by all rules, regulations, and laws applicable to the granting of such funds.

PART 3: That the City of Abilene and its Police Department will utilize any funds granted as outlined in the application for funds and match such funding with City monies as required.

PART 4: That this Resolution is effective on the part of the City of Abilene, Texas, on the date reflected hereon.
