RESOLUTION NO. 20-1988

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, WAIVING IMPROVEMENTS REQUIRED BY THE SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE FOR 1.5 ACRES OF THE W. J. REDDELL PRE-EMPTION SURVEY, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, LOCATED ON BELTWAY SOUTH (F.M. 707) IN ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Section 23-260(6) of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Abilene imposes certain requirements relative to the installation of sanitary sewer improvements; and,

WHEREAS, Thomas McIntire has filed a request that these requirements of the sanitary sewer improvements for 1.5 acres of the W. J. Reddell Pre-emption Survey, Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, (said property being more fully described on the attached Exhibit "A"), located on Beltway South (F.M. 707) in Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, be waived under the provisions of Section 23-262.8(A)(1) of said Subdivision Regulations; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That upon consideration of the request of Thomas McIntire, and after considering all relevant factors and staff recommendations in connection therewith, the City Council does hereby find and determine that it is in the best interest of the City to grant such request.

PART 2: That the City Council does hereby waive the requirements of Section 23-260(6) of the Subdivision Regulations of the City of Abilene, Texas, relative to the installation of sanitary sewer improvements for 1.5 acres of the W. J. Reddell Pre-emption Survey, Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, (said property being more fully

described on the attached Exhibit "A"), located on Beltway South (F.M. 707) in Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, as set out and described on the final plat which has been filed in connection with this request.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
