

RESOLUTION NO. 38-1988

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING GRANT AGREEMENT FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene desires to improve the Abilene Municipal Airport by rehabilitation of HIRL (high intensity runway lighting) Runway 17L-35R; rehabilitation of MITL (medium intensity taxiway lighting) Taxiway D, D1, D2, D3, D4, Taxiway B and portions of Taxiway M; install taxiway guidance signs; install security fencing, and,

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore made application to the Federal Aviation Administration for a grant to finance a portion of the costs of such improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has approved such grant agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that such grant agreement should be approved; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the grant application previously made is hereby ratified and the grant offer from the Federal Aviation Administration to provide funds for rehabilitation of HIRL (high intensity runway lighting) Runway 17L-35R; rehabilitation of MITL (medium intensity taxiway lighting) Taxiway D, D1, D2, D3, D4, Taxiway B and portions of Taxiway M; install taxiway guidance signs; install security fencing at the Abilene Municipal Airport be and the same is hereby in all things approved.

PART 2: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to sign such documents as necessary if the grant agreement is funded on behalf of the City of Abilene.

PART 3: That this resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
