

RESOLUTION NO. 28-1989

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID CITY ON AUGUST 12, 1989, FOR VOTER CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSITIONS ADOPTING ADDITIONAL SALES AND USE TAXES; AND PROVIDING FOR A PROCLAMATION NOTICE AND PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to hold an election in the City of Abilene, Texas, to allow voters to consider adoption of sales and use taxes within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas, is authorized by law to hold such election on August 12, 1989; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That an election be, and the same is hereby ordered to be held within the jurisdiction of the City of Abilene, Texas, on the 12th day of August, 1989, pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas, the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, and a contract between the City and Taylor County for election services. Such election shall be held for the following purposes:

To provide for voting for or against the following propositions:

(1) The adoption of an additional one-half of one percent sales and use tax within the City to be used to reduce the property tax rate.

(2) The adoption of an additional one-half of one percent sales and use tax within the City to be used for improving and promoting economic and industrial development.

Votes cast in such election shall be separately tallied, and separate tally sheets, polling lists, and other election forms and records shall be maintained and kept by City authorities.

SECTION 2: That any such tax approved pursuant to (1) above shall become effective January 1, 1990; that any such tax approved pursuant to (2) above shall become effective January 1, 1990.

SECTION 3: That the Mayor shall make proclamation of said City election and give notice thereof, and a copy of this order shall be sufficient notice of said election. Notice of the time and places of holding said election shall be given by publication of such notice in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Abilene at least thirty (30) days prior to the day of such election.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as indicated below.
