- PART 2: The maximum number of clerks for each voting precinct shall be four, and each judge shall attempt to appoint one clerk fluent both in English and Spanish.
- PART 3: The rate of compensation shall be Five and 00/100ths (\$5.00) Dollars per hour; provided, however, that each presiding judge delivering returns of the election shall be paid an additional Twenty-Five and 00/100ths (\$25.00) Dollars, for that service.
- PART 4: Absentee ballots shall be counted by the Absentee Ballot Board, as provided for by law.
- PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as indicated below.
