

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPOINTING A COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE FOR THE 1990 CENSUS FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSURING THAT EVERYONE IN ABILENE IS COUNTED IN THE 1990 CENSUS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene's political representation in the U.S. Congress is dependant on census population totals; and,

WHEREAS, many of Abilene's Federal and State funds are based on census statistics; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Abilene to insure that every person in the City is counted in the 1990 Census; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby appoints a Complete Count Committee for the 1990 Census because it is in the City's best interest to insure that everyone in the City is counted on census day 1990.

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
