

RESOLUTION NO. 45-1989

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
REGARDING A STRONG NATIONAL DRUG POLICY.

WHEREAS, we realize that we must aggressively attack the enemy
(drugs) that is destroying us from within; and,

WHEREAS, we realize the people of this country must unite and
inform our leaders that we "have had enough" of the problems
created by illegal drug use; and,

WHEREAS, we believe the casual attitude many young people have
toward illegal drug use must be addressed; and,

WHEREAS, we also believe the "social users" must be reached
before they become addicted; and,

WHEREAS, we realize that education of the next generation
alone will not confront the problem that exists presently; and,

WHEREAS, we urge the people of Abilene to unite and
collectively demand a strong drug policy to combat drug-related
tragedies; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS,
THAT:

PART 1: The City Council of Abilene, Texas, supports the
Mark Kilroy Foundation's efforts to gain enactment of a strong
national drug policy; and,

PART 2: The City Council of Abilene, Texas, will forward
this resolution to William J. Bennett, Director of National Drug
Control Policy; and,

PART 3: This resolution shall take effect immediately from
and after its passage.
