

RESOLUTION NO. 69-1989

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF 316 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, has been selected as a site for a TDCJ Maximum Security Prison; and,

WHEREAS, certain incentives for the TDCJ are necessary and appropriate to assure the location of said facility in Abilene; and,

WHEREAS, the City has available 316 acres of land, more or less, suitable for use as a prison site; and,

WHEREAS, said 316 acres of land, more or less, is surplus property for the City and the Water and Sewer Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the TDCJ requires said property to be provided at no cost to the TDCJ:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- PART 1. The City Council authorizes transfer of said property to the TDCJ within the time limit imposed by the TDCJ.
- PART 2. The Water and Sewer Fund shall be reimbursed fair value for the property.
- PART 3. The transfer of said property is contingent upon the Development Corporation of Abilene approving use of Development Corporation of Abilene funds to reimburse the Water and Sewer Fund.
- PART 4. The City Manager is authorized to execute all pertinent documents related to the property transfer.
- PART 5. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
