WHEREAS, in JONES COUNTY on COUNTY ROAD 303 from Farm to Market Road 1082 east approximately 2.4 miles to County Road 298, a distance of approximately 2.4 miles, local officials have requested the construction of a Farm to Market Road; and

WHEREAS, the construction of this Farm to Market Road will provide access to a new Department of Corrections facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Engineer-Director is hereby directed to tender the following proposal to the City of Abilene:

Provided the City of Abilene will:

1. Provide one hundred percent of the right of way clear of obstructions and free of cost to the State with acquisition procedures to be in accordance with policies of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation and with applicable Federal and State laws governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property.
2. Provide one hundred percent of the cost of all utility adjustments as may be required in accordance with policies of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation.

The State Department of Highways and Public Transportation will:

1. Designate a Farm to Market Road.
2. Provide relocation assistance as may be determined to be eligible under the Relocation Assistance Program.

3. Provide for construction.
4. Maintain that portion of the work which is its responsibility in accordance with maintenance agreements.

Upon acceptance of the provisions of this Order by the City of Abilene, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above referenced limits be and are hereby designated a part of the State Highway System as a FARM TO MARKET ROAD; and the Engineer-Director is hereby authorized to proceed in the most feasible and economical manner with project development to include any necessary agreements, right of way acquisition, utility adjustments, relocation assistance and construction at an estimated cost to the State of \$836,200.

This Order shall become operative upon acceptance by the City of Abilene; and if not accepted within 90 days of the date hereof, the action herein contained shall be automatically canceled.
