

RESOLUTION NO. 31-1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, REGULATING SMOKING IN CITY OWNED BUILDINGS AND URGING OTHER BUSINESSES TO ESTABLISH SMOKE FREE WORK ENVIRONMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas, adopted a Smoking Ordinance, 21-1987, restricting smoking in many public places; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas, has instituted a wellness program for its employees that includes a smoking cessation program; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Texas, is aware of studies that indicate the dangers of second hand smoke; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas, wishes to be an example for other businesses in the City in regard to the health issue of second hand smoke; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide a work environment for all City employees that is smoke free; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: That the City Council hereby adopts the attached policy "A" regarding a smoke free work environment for City facilities.

PART 2: That the City Council urges all businesses, industries, and others operating public places in the City of Abilene, Texas, to adopt similar policies for a smoke free work environment.


PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.



SMOKE FREE WORK ENVIRONMENT

Objective: To provide employees of the City with a work environment that is smoke free, thereby improving the health of each employee.

Initiating Agency: City Council/City Manager

Policy/Procedure:

- A. It is the policy of the City of Abilene that smoking will not be allowed in any facility or building owned by the City of Abilene.
- B. The only City owned facilities that are exempt from this policy are as follows:
 1. Those facilities leased to other entities or persons.
 2. Those facilities rented to other entities or persons.
- C. The above exemption does not apply when those facilities are not under lease or when they are not rented.

RESOLUTION NO. 32-1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPROVING A PROPOSED STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES AND PROJECTED USE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1990-91.

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the public interest that the City of Abilene request funds under the Community Development Block Grant Program authorized under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Public Law 93-383, as amended, for the City of Abilene situated in the Counties of Taylor and Jones, State of Texas; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held as required by said Act, at which public hearing interested members of the public were invited to offer comments regarding the various programs to be undertaken under the Act; and,

WHEREAS, the primary objective of the Community Development Program is to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment, and expand economic opportunities principally for persons of low and moderate income. Consistent with the primary objective, the Federal assistance provided in the Community Development Program is for the support of community development objectives which are eligible under applicable Federal regulations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- Part 1. That the Proposed Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds is hereby approved.
- Part 2. That said Statement be reconsidered at a later date and that a Final Statement be drafted at that time for submission to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- Part 3. That the financial assistance authorized by the Community Development Block Grant Program referred to above is required to enable the City of Abilene to carry on appropriate community development activities aimed toward meeting the objectives stated above.

Part 4. That the City Manager of the City of Abilene, Texas is hereby authorized to sign said application and any and all appurtenant documents on behalf of the City.

Part 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
