

RESOLUTION NO. 46-1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO LEASE CITY OWNED MINERAL RIGHTS FOR OIL AND GAS PURPOSES AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the City owns certain mineral rights located in Jones County, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate to offer same to the public in order that bids may be received to develop such mineral rights under an appropriate Oil & Gas Mineral Lease; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That notice should be given that the City desires to receive bids for an Oil & Gas Mineral Lease upon the terms and conditions and concerning the property described in that certain instrument captioned "Notice Of Intention Of The City Of Abilene To Lease Mineral Rights Owned By It For Oil And Gas Mineral Purposes," a true copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.


PART 2: That, upon passage of this resolution, the Purchasing Administrator be, and is hereby authorized and directed to cause to have published in the Western Observer, a newspaper of general circulation in Jones County therein, at least once a week for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks, a notice designating the time and place after such publication when bids will be received and considered for a mineral lease, as set forth therein, and calling a public hearing in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, in Abilene, Texas, at 9:00 A.M. on the 14th day of February, 1991,


to permit the public to be heard concerning the selection of the highest and best bidder submitting a bid.

PART 3: That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
