

RESOLUTION NO. 18-1991

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY AND THE CITY OF ABILENE TO REIMBURSE THE RAILROAD FOR THE RELOCATION OF FACILITIES TO ALLOW THE CITY TO WIDEN INDUSTRIAL BOULEVARD FROM SOUTH DANVILLE DRIVE TO SOUTH TREADAWAY BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene proposes to widen Industrial Boulevard from 48 feet to 64 feet in width between South Danville Drive and South Treadaway Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the proposed widening will require the relocation of certain facilities owned by the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company has reviewed and approved the design and proposed plans prepared by the City of Abilene as it relates to their facilities to be relocated, and have requested the City Council to enter into an agreement to reimburse Missouri Pacific Railroad Company for their costs in relocating said facilities; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: Assurance is hereby given that adequate funds have been appropriated and are available in the estimated amount of thirty-nine thousand four hundred eighty-two dollars (\$39,482.00) for payment to Missouri Pacific Railroad Company in satisfaction of sums agreed to in the above referenced agreement.

PART 2: Authorization is hereby granted for the Mayor to execute the referenced agreement on behalf of the City of Abilene; and

PART 3: That the Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
