

RESOLUTION NO. 35-1991

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE DESIGNATING CERTAIN OFFICIALS AS BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR, ACTING FOR, AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ABILENE IN DEALING WITH THE TEXAS FOREST SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARTICIPATING IN THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION TREE PLANTING GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Small Business Administration Appropriation Act, Public Law 101-515 was amended by adding Section 24 authorizing the Administrator to make grants to any State for the purpose of contracting with small businesses to plant trees on land owned or controlled by such State or local government; and

WHEREAS, Governor Ann Richards designated the program responsibility to the Texas Forest Services in June, 1991; and

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene is desirous of authorizing its administrative staff to represent and act for the City in dealing with the Texas Forest Service concerning this program;

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas:

Part 1: That the City of Abilene hereby commits its local match for the Highway 80 Landscape Project.

Part 2: That the City of Abilene hereby authorizes and directs its City Manager to represent and act for the City in dealing with the Texas Forest Service for the purpose of this program.

Part 3: The City of Abilene hereby designates its City Manager as the official authorized to serve as the City of Abilene's fiscal officer to receive grant funds for the purposes of this program.


Part 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
