

RESOLUTION NO. 42-1991

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPOINTING ASSISTANT MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES TO ACT IN THE ABSENCE OR UNAVAILABILITY OF THE JUDGE OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT.

WHEREAS, there are occasions when the Judge of the Municipal Court is temporarily unable to serve; and,

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Abilene provides for the appointment of Assistant Municipal Court Judges to act when the Municipal Court Judge is unavailable; and,

WHEREAS, the Judge of the Municipal Court has contacted Mary Glover and Kenneth Leggett, qualified and competent attorneys, who have agreed to serve in his absence and recommends their appointment as Assistant Municipal Court Judges, in accordance with the City Charter of the City of Abilene; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby approves of the appointment of Mary Glover and Kenneth Leggett as Assistant Municipal Court Judges of Abilene, Texas, and hereby authorizes the Mayor to appoint Mary Glover and Kenneth Leggett for a term of two (2) years beginning October 24, 1991, and continuing through October, 1993.


PART 2: That Mary Glover and Kenneth Leggett shall be paid only for the actual time that they serve as Assistant Municipal Court Judges.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.


