

RESOLUTION NO. 43-1991

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPOINTING AN AFFORDABLE HOUSING TASK FORCE, DEFINING THE SCOPE OF WORK AND IDENTIFYING TARGETED GOALS.

WHEREAS, the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 requires each jurisdiction receiving Community Development Block Grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to prepare a Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy; and,

WHEREAS, the city's initial submission of the Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy submitted on or about October 31, 1991 should be reviewed and amended annually; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to have citizens involved in the development and preparation of the housing strategy;


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS THAT:

1. The Mayor of the City of Abilene appoint a citizen committee to be known as the Abilene Affordable Housing Task Force.
2. The members of the Task Force will serve at the will and pleasure of the Mayor but no longer than one year.
3. The Task Force, with support from City staff, will identify housing needs, compile available market and inventory data, develop strategies to meet identifiable needs, define and locate resources, and prepare the housing strategy.
4. After the proposed housing strategy is prepared, the Task Force will hold two public hearings to receive citizen comments.
5. The Task Force should meet at least once a month beginning in November, 1991, and submit the completed housing strategy to the City Council no later than the second regular Council meeting in May of 1992.
