

RESOLUTION NO. 15-1992

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING WEST TEXAS UTILITIES COMPANY TO FURNISH FLOODLIGHTING SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, on the 31st day of October, 1991, West Texas Utilities Company filed its request for approval of a new leased lighting tariff for Floodlighting Service with the Public Utility Commission of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Public Utility Commission of Texas approved the leased lighting tariff for Floodlighting Service on February 5, 1992; and

WHEREAS, West Texas Utilities Company has requested that the City Council authorize the provision of the Floodlighting Service within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such Floodlighting Service is reasonable and should be authorized; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That West Texas Utilities Company is hereby authorized to provide Floodlighting Service within the City of Abilene.

PART 2: That the charge for Floodlighting Service within the City of Abilene shall be that set forth in the Rate Schedule, as previously approved by the Public Utility Commission of Texas on February 5, 1992, which is attached hereto.

PART 3: That this authorization is valid only for installations of such Floodlighting Service which do not violate the City's Zoning Ordinance or other applicable City codes and regulations.


PART 4: That this Resolution shall become effective for service rendered from and after the date this Resolution is adopted.



FLOODLIGHTING SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available for private outdoor floodlighting service. Under the schedule the Company will construct, own, operate, energize and maintain metal halide or high pressure sodium luminaires, mounted on a composite pole of a design approved by the Company and cause each light to operate from dusk to dawn.

Fuel Cost Recovery Charge: Plus a fixed fuel factor charge accordance with Rate FFF, sheet number 26, applicable to estimated kWh per light per month.

Gross Receipts Tax Adjustment: Subject to Rate GRTA, sheet number 27.

FACILITIES PROVIDED

Company will install, own and maintain at its own cost and expense the luminaire, lamp, photo control, mounting bracket and mounting hardware at each light location.
