

RESOLUTION NO. 19-1992

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A CITYLINK ADA ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to ensuring that persons with disabilities are not discriminated against in any service, program, or activity provided by CityLink; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to ensuring that persons with disabilities are given the opportunity to provide input into the policies and practices of CityLink; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration regulations promulgated as a result of the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 require the City of Abilene to develop and annually update an ADA Paratransit Plan; and

WHEREAS, the citizen participation mechanism for the ADA Paratransit Plan requires the establishment of a CityLink ADA Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Handicap Advisory Committee, created by the City Council on June 12, 1980, has fulfilled the function for which it was created; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That a CityLink ADA Advisory Board is hereby created to provide emphasis, assistance, information, and support to the City Council to ensure the efficient and effective operation of CityLink's services for persons with disabilities and adherence to the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990, subsequent regulations promulgated by the Federal Transit Administration, and CityLink's ADA Paratransit Plan.


PART 2: That the attached Purpose and Procedures of CityLink ADA Advisory Board are hereby adopted to govern the operation of the Board.

PART 3: That the Handicap Advisory Committee is hereby abolished.


PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
