

RESOLUTION NO. 20-1992

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene desires to provide for a safe learning environment for the students of Cooper High School; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide positive impact on student perception of Police Officers; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that the students of Cooper High School be educated as to the harmful effects of drug and alcohol abuse, be provided with information regarding crime prevention techniques, and other factors that affect their lives;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: That the City hereby approves the submission of a grant application for a total of \$37,567.00 to the Criminal Justice Division of the office of the Governor of the State of Texas, the grant to be used to fund the Cooper High School Criminal Justice Education Program.

Part 2. That of the total amount of \$37,567.00, \$8,449.00 in matching funds will be provided by the City, as required by the provisions of the grant application.

Part 3. That the City Manager is authorized to sign the grant application on behalf of the City of Abilene.

Part 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
