

RESOLUTION NO. 24-1992

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, NAMING THE BRIDGE AT EAST HIGHWAY 80 AND CEDAR CREEK THE "DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE" AND REQUESTING THAT THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ALLOW A MEMORIAL MARKER AND PLAQUE TO BE PLACED ON STATE HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, a request has been made to the City Council of the City of Abilene to name the bridge at East Highway 80 and Cedar Creek the "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Bridge"; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene wholeheartedly concurs in the request to recognize Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Abilene shares Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s dream which became the cornerstone and essence of human rights, and which caused the world to understand that every human being has value, worth and dignity; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby names the bridge at East Highway 80 and Cedar Creek the "Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Bridge".

PART 2: That the City Council requests that the Texas Department of Transportation allow a memorial-marker and plaque to be placed on State Highway Department right-of-way adjacent to the bridge.

PART 3. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
