

RESOLUTION NO. 26-1992

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF TEXAS FOR A SPECIAL FOUR MONTH SELECTIVE ENFORCEMENT PROJECT FOR VEHICLE OCCUPANT PROTECTION.

WHEREAS, Article 6701j-1, Texas Civil Statutes, declares that the establishment, development, and maintenance of a program of traffic safety in Texas is a vital governmental purpose and function of the State and its legal and political subdivisions; and,

WHEREAS, the Engineer-Director has formulated a program of projects for the current fiscal year called the Highway Safety Plan (HSP), and the United States Department of Transportation (US DOT) has approved the HSP and authorized the Department to proceed with implementation in accordance with approved procedures; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and its Police Department desire to implement an occupant protection selective traffic enforcement project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City hereby approves the submission of a grant application for a special four month selective enforcement project on occupant protection.

PART 2: That Dwain T. Pyburn, Chief of Police, is authorized to sign the grant application and contract on behalf of the City of Abilene.


PART 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
