
WHEREAS, a Farm to Market Highway has been designated as F.M. Highway 3522 and is to be constructed from F.M. Highway 1082, to approximately 2.4 miles east, a distance of 2.384 miles.

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration requires that the Texas Department of Transportation District Office maintain in their files for documentation purposes a Certification of Compliance with Title III of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, Texas, that the right of way for F.M. Highway 3522 has been acquired according to the policies of the Texas Department of Transportation and in compliance with the Federal Regulations, Part 25 of Title 49 CFR - Uniform Relocation and Real Property Acquisition for Federal and Federally Assisted Programs governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property. 


