

RESOLUTION NO. 48-1992

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING A DRAINAGE FACILITY AND WATERWAY AGREEMENT WITH THE MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY TO REIMBURSE THE RAILROAD FOR REMOVING AND RESTORING ITS TRACKS TO FACILITATE INSTALLATION OF DRAIN PIPES AND THE OTHER DRAINAGE RELATED IMPROVEMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH WIDENING OF INDUSTRIAL BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has begun widening of Industrial Boulevard between South Danville Drive and South Treadaway Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Industrial Boulevard widening, the City of Abilene proposes to improve the drainage by installing drain pipes and other drainage related improvements within the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Missouri Pacific Railroad Company has reviewed and approved the design and proposed plan prepared by the City of Abilene as it relates to the installation of drainage related improvements, and has requested that the City enter into a Drainage Facility and Waterway Agreement to reimburse Missouri Pacific Railroad Company for its costs relative to removing and restoring its tracks to facilitate installation of the proposed drainage related improvements; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the referenced Drainage Facility and Waterway Agreement on behalf of the City of Abilene.

RESOLUTION CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS #49-1992

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City ordered an election to be held in said City on October 10, 1992, on the PROPOSITIONS hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said City Council.

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Vernon's Ann. Civ. St. Article 6252-17.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

1. That the City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered, and that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Resolution calling said election.

2. That the City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election, on the submitted PROPOSITIONS by the resident, qualified electors of said City, who voted at the election:

8,832 VOTES: AGAINST )

PROPOSITION NO. 2

7,391 VOTES: FOR )

THE ISSUANCE OF \$925,000 FIRE TRUCKS, EQUIPMENT, AND TRAINING TOWER IMPROVEMENT TAX BONDS

5,161 VOTES: AGAINST )

PROPOSITION NO. 3

5,560 VOTES: FOR )

THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,335,000 STREET, SIDEWALK, AND TRAFFIC CONTROL IMPROVEMENT TAX BONDS

6,950 VOTES: AGAINST )

PROPOSITION NO. 4

5,765 VOTES: FOR )

THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,980,000 CREEK CLEANING AND CLEARING AND OTHER DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT TAX BONDS

6,765 VOTES: AGAINST )

3. That the City Council officially finds, determines and declares the result of said election to be that the PROPOSITION NO. 2 so submitted has received a favorable majority vote in all respects and has carried.


4. That the aforesaid bonds may be issued, as voted and as provided by law.

5. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as indicated below.
