PART 3: The rate of compensation shall be Five and 00/100ths (\$5.00) Dollars per hour; provided, however, that each presiding judge delivering returns of the election shall be paid an additional Twenty-Five and 00/100ths (\$25.00) Dollars, for that service.

PART 4: Early voting ballots shall be counted by the Early Voting Ballot Board, as provided for by law.

PART 5: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as indicated below.

PART 6: That the Terms of this appointment shall be for the May 1 election and for the runoff election as set by Section 3 of Resolution 9-1993.
