

RESOLUTION NO. 20-1993

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING AN INVITATION TO THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE TO HOLD ITS 1995 ANNUAL LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE FOR THE ASSOCIATION OF MAYORS, COUNCILMEMBERS AND COMMISSIONERS AT THE ABILENE CIVIC CENTER IN ABILENE, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the Texas Municipal League (TML) is currently making plans for its 1995 Annual TML Leadership Institute for the Association of Mayors, Councilmembers and Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene offers excellent convention facilities for hosting such a conference and can provide accommodations and entertainment for conference participants and their guests; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the Mayor and members of the City Council of the City of Abilene hereby cordially invite the Association of Mayors, Councilmembers and Commissioners to hold its 1995 Annual Leadership Institute at the Abilene Civic Center in Abilene, Texas.

Further, the City of Abilene agrees to meet the criteria outlined in the bid specification for the 1995 conference by way of designated staff assistance and financial obligations.


III.


