BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 11th day of November, 1993, at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas at which Gary McCaleb, Mayor, presided and the following council members were present: Paul R. Vasquez, Betty Ray, Jimmy McNeil, Russell Berry, Ray Ferguson, and Liz Herrera, when the following resolution was unanimously adopted:


WHEREAS, a Farm to Market Highway has been designated as F.M. Highway 1082 and is to be constructed from the Jones/Taylor County line to F.M. Highway 3522, a distance of 2.856 miles.

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration requires that the Texas Department of Transportation District Office maintain in their files for documentation purposes a Certification of Compliance with Title III of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Abilene, Texas that the right of way for F.M. Highway 1082 has been acquired according to the policies of the Texas Department of Transportation and in compliance with the Federal Regulations, Part 25 of Title 49 CFR - Uniform Relocation and Real Property Acquisition for Federal and Federally Assisted Programs governing the acquisition policies for acquiring real property. Documentation for compliance with these requirements is available for audit in our files.
