

RESOLUTION NO. 8-1993

A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AND TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, CALLING FOR JOINT ELECTIONS ON MAY 1, 1993.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and Taylor County both will hold elections on May 1, 1993, for Mayor, City Council positions, U.S. Senatorial election and such other issues as may be necessary and/or required; and

WHEREAS, both the City of Abilene and Taylor County agree that a joint election will benefit the City and County voters; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AND COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS:

PART 1: The City and County agree to jointly share the election expenses of the precincts that lie within the City limits of Abilene and Taylor County, Texas.

PART 2: The City and County agree to the following procedure for determining the expenses for the City of Abilene and Taylor County, Texas:

The total actual expenses will be divided by the total Taylor County election precincts (38 + 1 early voting for a total of 39).

A per precinct cost will then be determined and the City and the County will split the actual expenses to the 27 precincts that lie within the City limits of Abilene, equally. The County agrees to pay 100% of the actual expenses for the 11 precincts that lie outside the City limits of Abilene, but within Taylor County.


PART 3: The City and County agree that the actual expenses born by the parties shall be based on the items set out in Exhibit A, attached. Both parties recognize the actual cost may be more or may be less than is set out in the estimated expenses in Exhibit A.

PART 4: That if the City and County should have run-off elections on the same date, the cost shall be shared, per the above provisions. If the County does not have a run-off election on the same date, the City shall pay the cost of the run-off election, per the attached Exhibit A.

RESOLUTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS

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COUNTY OF TAYLOR

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WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Taylor County Commissioners Court that on May 1, 1993, Taylor County will conduct a Special Election for U. S. Senator, and such constitutional amendments as are required by the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Taylor County Commissioners Court that on May 1, 1993, the City of Abilene, will conduct an election for Mayor and City Council positions.

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Commissioners Court agrees that a joint election with the City of Abilene will benefit the voters of Taylor County:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Taylor County agrees to hold a joint election with the City of Abilene on the following terms:

Taylor County agrees that the County Elections Administrator shall assume primary responsibility for carrying out and fulfilling the mechanical and procedural matters and requirements necessary for the preparation for and conduct of said joint election. The total actual expenses will be divided by the total Taylor County election precincts (38 + 1 early voting for a total of 39).

A per precinct cost will then be determined and the City and the County will split the actual expenses to the 27 precincts that lie within the City limits of Abilene, equally. The County agrees to pay 100% of the actual expenses for the 11 precincts that lie outside the City limits of Abilene, but within Taylor County.

The County agrees that the actual expenses born by the parties shall be based on the items set out in Exhibit A, attached. Both parties recognize the actual cost may be more or may be less than is set out in the estimated expenses in Exhibit A.

That if the City and County should have run-off elections on the same date, the cost shall be shared, per the above provisions. If the County does not have a run-off election on the same date, the City shall pay the cost of the run-off election, per the attached Exhibit A.
