## RESOLUTION NO. 9-1993

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE USAGE OF COUNTY POLLING PLACES AND ELECTION PRECINCTS FOR THE JOINT CITY-COUNTY ELECTIONS ON MAY 1, 1993, AND RUN-OFF ELECTION ON MAY 22, 1993.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has previously passed Resolutions 2-1993 and 3-1993; and,

WHEREAS, Resolutions 2-1993 and 3-1993, provide for ten (10) City election precincts and polling places; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene and Taylor County have agreed to hold a joint election on May 1, 1993; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Resolutions 2-1993 and 3-1993 shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Resolution.

SECTION 2: That the City of Abilene shall use the polling places and election precincts that Taylor County has previously established per the attached Election Proclamation for the election on May 1, 1993.

SECTION 3: That if the City and County should both have a run-off election on the same day, the City shall use the polling places and precincts established by the County per the attached Election Proclamation. If the County does not have a run-off election on the same date as the City, the City shall use the polling places and precincts established by Resolution 3-1993.
